

State Board Compliance Overview


Every 2 years all state licensing boards renew their registration with the NPDB. A subset of these boards are selected to participate in the NPDB compliance review process to assess the completeness and accuracy of reportable actions submitted.

After NPDB review, the compliance and attestation results are shared publicly on the NPDB Compliance Map.



Compliance Review Status by State

<p>Compliant</p> <p>All reportable actions are submitted.</p>	<p>Attested</p> <p>All required actions are submitted.</p>
<p>Not Fully Compliant</p> <p>At least 95% of reportable actions are submitted.</p>	<p>Could Not Attest</p> <p>Cannot certify all required actions are submitted.</p>
<p>Non-Compliant</p> <p>Reportable actions and/or data are not submitted.</p>	<p>Failed to Attest</p> <p>Attestation not completed by due date.</p>
